Engineering Scholarship

Students eligible for any of the four presidential scholarship awards and majoring in engineering are also eligible for an Engineering Scholarship of \$1,000 a year, renewable for four years. Students must maintain a 3.0 to keep their scholarship.

Klamath County \$1000 Scholarship

Students who graduated from a High School in Klamath County are eligible for a one-year non-renewable scholarship of \$1,000. Applicants must have a 3.0 cumulative high school GPA and a minimum 1050 SAT* or 21 ACT composite test score. Transfer students are not eligible for the Klamath County scholarship.

Other Eligibility Criteria*

Students enrolled in the OHSU Nursing program, Pre-Dental Hygiene, the Clinical Lab Science program, the Paramedic Program, Post-baccalaureate courses and the LaGrande ODS School of Dental Hygiene are not eligible for these scholarships. Additionally, International Students, students attending Oregon Tech through the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program, students receiving reciprocity, and Online Education are not eligible for these scholarships.

Prior to entering the OHSU Nursing program, Pre-Nursing students are eligible for the scholarships.



Students must be admitted by March 1 to be eligible for the scholarships.

Students will be evaluated for eligibility through the admissions application process. Scholarships are awarded only to new fully-admitted students who are beginning Fall term. Presidential and engineering scholarships are renewable up to four years.

Awards may vary depending on level of academic achievement, academic standing, major and financial need.
